For golfers who want to upgrade their skills in any areas of their golf technique and course management, or to receive the latest scientific analysis of the performance of their equipment, this is the perfect package for you. Golfers will have the chance of one-to-one supervision and coaching with Asian Tour Player, Chris Rodgers, during the 4 days 3 nights trip and will have the opportunity to use the 'Trackman' facility to measure and compare the key characteristics of their ball-striking (launch angle, spin, distance and ball flight etc) with their own clubs versus other available brands or types of shaft.

The standard golf package includes 2 days of on-course lessons led by Chris Rodgers with the participants, in which he will discuss course management options, together with a few personal tips for each player. After the 2 days activity, there will be a full report for individual golfers on their improvement and changes during the training.

For those die-hard golfers who have the time, you will have the option of extending the 2 days training to 3 days instead. This 3 days golf drill will contribute tremendously to your golf game. On the other hand, for those who want a rest and a relaxing vacation, you have the choice of going on a leisure trip after the 2 days golfing at Black Mountain.

There will be no transport hassles as mini buses will be available to take you around town or to nearby National Parks, where you will be able to enjoy visiting beautiful scenery, or indulge in boundless shopping or even a relaxing Thai Massage while you are in town.

Chris Rodgers turned professional at the end of 1999 following a string of successes on the amateur circuit. As a member of the English Men's Team from 1993 – 1999, Chris won 17 out of a possible 18 matches.



Chris first ventured to Asia in 2002 before enjoying success back in Europe in 2003. The decision to move to Bangkok at the end of 2005 and concentrate once again on the Asian Tour saw immediate benefits when Chris won the 2006 Asian Tour School and then won the Pakistan Open the following week. This earned him the right to play in the HSBC Champions event in Shanghai later in the year.

The following season continued the successful theme with three top 10 finishes including a strong performance at the Volvo Masters where he finished second, bringing him to 26th on the Asian Tour OOM. He was also invited to play in the prestigious Dunhill Links tournament in Scotland.

More recently, in March 2009, he finished second in the Black Mountain Masters and won the 2010 Camry Invitational.

He now lives in Thailand.

Chris has been guest studio expert in a number of Golf TV shows and recently worked as an on-course Golf Commentator for The Asian Tour. This is something he is very interested in pursuing in the future as a great add-on to his growing CV. He has also made a series of teaching videos for Asian Tour Media



Training Schedule

Day 1

Meet the PRO at the range around 3pm for introduction to PRO and assessment of individual student's swing. Note that this is not a lesson but for the PRO's assessment only. This is also a good chance for the student to know more about the PRO and build rapport.

Day 2

Morning – 18 Holes

PRO will follow the students (Ratio 4 student : 1 PRO) on course to evaluate how each individual student plays on course, their course management and shots consistency. A detailed report will be given to students on their weaknesses on course and the areas which they need to work on.

Afternoon – Range Practice

Detailed discussion on each student's course management and let them know which area to improve on. Followed by swing analysis and long game shots.

Day 3

Morning – Range

Short Game & Putting Lesson + Practice

Afternoon – 18 Holes

PRO follows students and teaches them how to get out of awkward lies and advising on ball position etc when necessary. Demonstration of different approach methods for short game shots.

REPORT

After the end of the training session, each student will get a detailed report from the PRO commenting on their weaknesses and which areas they need to improve on. Their swing faults and cure for the swing faults.
